## PORTOFOLIO REVIEW – VISUAL ARTS

### Grades 4-5

#### **Portfolio Content**

Each portfolio must include a minimum of 5 samples.

At least 3 of the following 5 categories must be represented:

1. Pencil drawing
2. Design using color and texture
3. Drawing of a building (color optional)
4. Color comparison demonstrating knowledge of perspective (overlapping shapes, near/far, linear, etc.)
5. 3-D art project

#### **Criteria**

**Review Points / 1-5 scale (15 of 20 possible points to qualify on this criteria)**

1. Displays creativity in composition, use of space, and texture
2. Displays effective, interesting usages of color, demonstrating knowledge of color relationship
3. Demonstrates understanding of basic elements of perspective
4. Demonstrates understanding, usage of pattern

### Grades 6-8

#### **Portfolio Content**

**Each portfolio must include a minimum of 5 samples.**

At least 3 of the following 5 categories must be represented:

1. Pencil drawing (human figure drawing)
2. Design using color (choice of media)
3. Design using lettering (record album cover, poster, etc.)
4. Mechanical or free-hand drawing of a building or other composition demonstrating use of perspective
5. 3-D art project

#### **Criteria**

**Review Points / 1-5 scale (15 of 20 possible points to qualify on this criteria)**

1. Demonstrates creativity, balance in overall composition
2. Displays understanding of color relationships in color usage
3. Understands and effectively uses elements of perspective
4. Demonstrates shading techniques, tonal qualities, and relationships
